2. Whose information do we process?

We collect information from customers and potential customers as well as partners.

3. What information do we collect?

First name, last name, email address, phone number, company name, company website address, IP address.

4. Why do we collect data?

The personal data collected is used to maintain and manage customer relationships and to enable contacts required by the service. In addition, personal information may be used for direct marketing. Holvia Group Oy collects personal information to make its customer service smoother and individualised.

5. Where do we get the information from?

The register is used for collecting information from the individuals themselves and from registers maintained by authorities or companies within legal boundaries.

6. Who else processes your data?

Your data is processed by Google Analytics, Facebook and LinkedIn. Information will be disclosed outside the company only to the extent required by order delivery and technical solutions. Data will not be regularly transferred or disclosed outside the EU or the European Economic Area.

Use of cookies

We use cookies

Our website uses cookies. Cookies and the information collected through them are used to improve the efficiency and user-friendliness of services. Cookies collect information about how visitors navigate and what they do on the website. The information obtained through the cookies is anonymous. However, within the framework of privacy legislation, information obtained through the use of cookies and other technologies may be combined with information obtained from a user in any other context. We ask your permission to use cookies when you visit our website. The cookies used on the site are classified into

different categories. You can edit your preferences at any time in our site's cookie settings or by changing your browser settings. You will find detailed instructions in this statement.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that a website stores in a user's browser during a website visit. Cookies collect and store information that allows you to log in to the website, use an e-commerce shopping cart and analyse your behaviour on the website to improve the website functionality.

Third-party cookies

We use third-party cookies on the website. Holvia Group Oy uses platforms provided by third parties, such as Facebook and Google Ads, for digital communications, among other things. These platforms use both first-party and third-party cookies and similar technologies to advertise and track advertising results.

We use third-party cookies to understand and track how you browse different websites. We receive information about these cookies; however, the information can also be used for other purposes specified by third parties. The third-party cookies found on our website are subject to third-party privacy policies.

Various cookies

We use cookies on our website to collect and analyse website performance and usage, to provide social media features as well as to improve and customise content and ads. Here are the details about the cookies we use.

Necessary cookies

These cookies are necessary to provide core functionalities of the website. The website will not work properly without these cookies, which are enabled by default. We do not need your consent to place these cookies, but you can delete them by changing your browser settings. Deleting cookies affects the functionality of the website, disabling some of the functionalities.

Functional cookies

Preferential cookies allow a website to store information that enables us to customise the look or behaviour of the website according to user preferences. Accepting cookies will enhance your experience when you visit the website.

Analytical cookies

We use analytical cookies to develop the website by collecting and reporting information about the use of the website. Cookies allow us to make the site even better and more user-friendly.

Marketing cookies

We use marketing cookies to track visitors to our site so that we can target our site visitors with relevant engaging ads.

Cookie management

We will save your cookie selection for 12 months unless you revoke your consent. We will then ask for your consent again. If you make any changes to the settings, that information will be saved for 14 days.

You can edit your selected cookie settings at any time. On the right bottom corner of our site, you will find the link "Cookies". Clicking on the link will allow you to edit your previous selections. If you are updating your selections, we recommend refreshing your browser, allowing new cookie settings to come into effect.

You may need to change your browser settings and manually delete cookies to clear your device from previously configured cookies.

Managing browser cookie settings

You can manage your cookie settings in your web browser's cookie management settings. On browsers' own websites you can find instructions on how to manage cookies in your browser. If you block all cookies in your browser settings, it may affect the performance of our site and your user experience. Blocking cookies may result in website performance issues, and some essential functionalities may not work at all.
